### SCHOLARSHIP GOALS

- 2. To enable students to attain a post secondary education that will educate and train them to make a positive contribution in the community he/she lives.
- 3. To support a core group of student leaders who are eager to build and strengthen their life and our community.
- 4. To serve as an incentive, encouraging other students toward involvement in the betterment of our community.

# **CTFK "FUTURE BUILDERS" SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

The following guidelines identify eligibility requirements for the CTFK "Future Builders" Scholarship program of financial assistance. This program is open for application to students graduating from Wagener-Salley High School at the end of the 2021-2022 school year who enter and attend an accredited or approved institution of higher learning.

- 1. A student's eligibility for a scholarship is based on intent to seek a degree, certificate, or license from an accredited or approved institution.
- 2. Applications will be considered from high school individuals who are enrolled in the Wagener-Salley High School.
- 3. Those applying for a scholarship as first-year students must demonstrate academic ability (acceptance without academic probation), church/community involvement, and have the potential to be successful at the post-secondary level.
- 4. This scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, ethnic origin, or physical disability.
- 5. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the educational institution that the student will be attending in two installments. First installment at the time validation from institution of attendance and second installment after successful completion of the first semester and enrollment of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.
- 6. The recipient is expected to maintain academic and personal performance consistent with the original award criteria.
- 7. *Completed* application forms must be mailed to CTFK no later than <u>April 15</u><sup>th</sup>.
- 8. <u>THE APPLICATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED WITH THE FOLLOWING REQUIRED</u> <u>INFORMATION:</u>
  - a. Applicant's essay of not more than 500 words on the following topic: Describe the course of study you wish to pursue at the post-secondary level and explain how your education will prepare you to be a better servant of Christ. Also include any community service you have been a part of.
  - b. A letter of recommendation from their Pastor or other church leader
  - c. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or school administrator who has knowledge of the applicant's character and educational/vocational interest.
  - d. A history of the applicant's employment (if applicable) and community service.
  - e. References; Name and phone numbers of references who would be able to attest for applicant's character (references can not be the same as letters of recommendation). (minimum of two names and phone numbers).
  - f. An official certified high school transcript.
- 9. When your application is received by CTFK we will email you and/or mail you a confirmation of receipt.
- 10. An interview will be conducted with all applicants by Churches Together for Kids Scholarship Committee. You will be contacted to setup interview times. Interviews will be held the first few weeks in May. Please indicate your preference of contact on the application
